MANAGING DIRECTOR REPORT



RISING TO THE CHALLENGE

THE MARCH QUARTER HAS BEEN A VERY CHALLENGING PERIOD IN BUSINESS.

Box&Co managed to maintain a reasonable level of activity with enquiry levels increasing slightly toward the end of March.

The general sentiment across all industries has been very negative. Enquiry level and new project starts has been very low in comparison to previous years. The main factors influencing this include:

- The inability of all levels of government to make decisions that promote productivity and activity
- The steep reduction in the resources sector which has a ripple affect across numerous industries.

It is envisaged that Q4 15/16 will be much more buoyant as other areas of the economy start to perform.

High density residential construction continues to drag along and distort overall construction activity and it is envisaged that this will start a steep decline in the next 12 months.

There will need to be a concentrated effort from Government in 16/17 to start major infrastructure spending to help push the economy into gear.






