Inconsistent work flow and short activity cycles are the new normal for our part of the industry. We are experiencing micro cycles within each calendar year which have made it very challenging for planning of resources.

Box&Co has accepted this new trend and have made sure that our systems and procedures are agile.

The residential market has continued to weaken and whilst there are some small increases in the commercial sector, it is not significant enough to soften the effects of the declining residential market. On this basis, we predict greater competition in the commercial space in 17/18.

The federal budget was relatively positive for our sector with a hope that increased spending

will occur on infrastructure and housing. This will in turn assist the commercial sector through broad economic momentum.

Box&Co has performed solidly over this period largely due to our focus on service and professionalism across all levels of the business. This approach has resulted in continued growth with existing repeat clients.



REGIS PROJECT WRAPS UP


BOX&CO IS NEARING THE COMPLETION OF RENOVATIONS AT TWO FACILITIES FOR REGIS AGED CARE.

The five month project involved extensive refurbishment of two live aged care facilities at Sandgate. We will show you the finished product in the next edition of the newsletter.










