BOX&CO ARE BACK AT THE FLAGSTONE HOTEL SITE COMPLETING THE COLD SHELL FIT OUT.


Works involve installation of the roofing, internal and external walls and ceilings, services, and a significant amount of feature glazing to allow for a bright and modern pub setting.

PROJECT 'WHITEBOX' COMPLETE

THE 'WHITE BOX' AT THE HEART OF CUSTOM FOODS' NEW MANUFACTURING FACILITY, COMPLETED IN MARCH, IS ESSENTIALLY A MASSIVE ESKY, COSTING JUST OVER \$1M TO CONSTRUCT.

Over 6000m² of PIR Insulated Panel was installed to create the 'esky' to meet Custom Foods' bespoke requirements and strict food hygiene compliance.

PIR stands for 'POLYISOCYANURATE' which is a thermoset plastic, closed cell, rigid insulation with great thermal efficiency. The panel is supported by high tensile strength cables and can support up to 120kg per metre.


